### **BACKGROUND**

On January 15, 2009, digital identity, healthcare and eCitizen thought leaders held a workshop at the MIT Media Lab with virtual external connectivity to discuss and draft recommendations for the digital identity enablement of two goals in the Obama-Biden technology agenda: **Create a Transparent and Connected Democracy** and **Lower Health Care Costs by Investing in Electronic Information Technology Systems**.
